# **WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY**

#### Workers are responsible for:

- Following reasonable instructions and using equipment provided by the PCBU to protect their health and safety while at work
- Identifying and reporting any workplace incidents or hazards to their supervisor
- Being involved in the resolution of work health and safety issues
- Protecting their health and safety and that of others by not working while under the influence of alcohol or other drugs
- Not interfering with, or removing any safety guards, safety devices or protective equipment provided by the PCBU

• Abide by work health and safety legal responsibilities, and follow any reasonable instructions and advice while at the PCBU workplace
